Abstract

Main expressionists of the micrasian movement are the non profit organizations and their secondary carriers. In an environment with raised financial difficulties and many competitive activities and by the adoption of new living standards, unions and their organizations should reconsider their old opinions about the role, their function and their relationship with their other members. Today, it is observed quantitative and qualitative shortage of executives, non obvious distribution of responsibilities, shortage of renewing of stuff knowledge, separating of cultural dynamic, incomplete technical/material infrastructure and festivals with no imagination and new ideas that reproduce the same thematology. In today's competitive circumstances it is extremely important the audience of cultural festivals to be in the center of unions attendance. The main role of unions is the growth of audience participation in which they refer to in the creative procedures of developing cultural products but also for their consumption. The mean of quality of t he offered cultural products must be connected with satisfaction of the audience needs. Drawing of the audience allows the provision of its future tends and adoption of the proper strategies by the unions.
